

>**proof of de·pos·it**< verification of the dollar amount on a check or draft being deposited. This is done by comparing the handwritten amount on the check to the amount written on the accompanying deposit slip. It is the only step in check processing that has not been automated fully.

Dictionary of Banking Terms

>MirrorImage **im·age POD**< allows you to migrate from your current paper based proof operation to a Check21 ready, image-based proof workflow fully integrated with your core banking application and the Federal Reserves' FedWire service.

im·age POD takes advantage of the provisions of Check21 eliminating the need for machine-readable, hard-encoded items.

im·age POD is capable of generating substitute checks (IRD's) for exchange with non-image institutions.

im·age POD creates a posting file for upload to your core accounting system and generates your image cash letter for transmission to the Federal Reserve.

The implementation of Check21 in October 2004 will allow your financial institution to further leverage the advantages of image processing.
